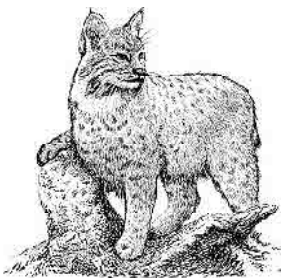
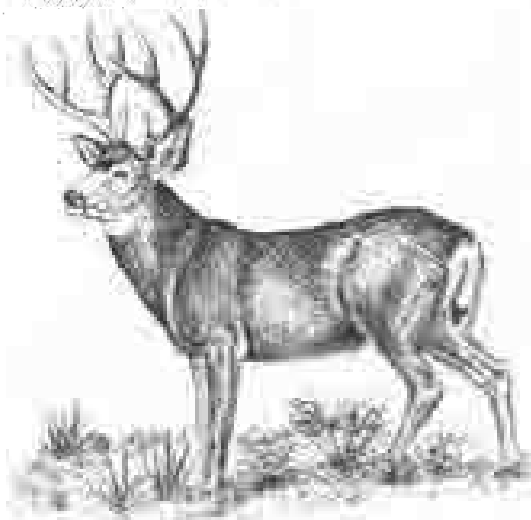

Type or print orders clearly and be sure to give item # and description of item, quantity, price and size/color of each item. Louisiana Residents include 4% Sales Tax. Please allow sufficient funds to cover merchandise and shipping & insurance costs.

WE DO NOT PAY SHIPPING CHARGES.

Any excess will be credited for use on future orders. Orders that are short of money will be sent **C.O.D.** with an added \$9.00 C.O.D. fee. *(See COD's section on following page for method of payments for COD's.)* Please include your complete shipping address and daytime telephone number. If your mailing and shipping address are different, please be certain to specify on each order as this information is not stored in our computer. UPS will return boxes not addressed correctly which will result in extra cost to you. If UPS does find you at an address other than the one addressed to, they will charge for this service and this cost will be passed on to you. Any address correction charges from UPS will be billed to you. Note: Please order under the same name on every order to avoid confusion or duplication of files.

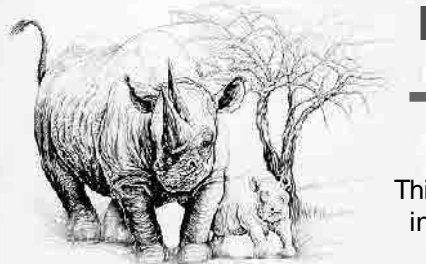
Telephone Orders:

Our office is open between **9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. CST** Monday thru Friday. After regular hours we have an answering machine for your convenience. We are glad to take phone orders. Please have all of the required information **BEFORE** you call us. Our clerks are ready to take your orders as fast and accurately as possible. Telephone orders will be shipped C.O.D. *(See COD's section on following page for method of payments for COD's.)* or you may charge the order to your Mastercard, Visa Card or Discover Card. Please be sure to clearly state your complete credit card number and expiration date on your order. We also offer "Check by Phone" payments.

(All credit card purchases will be billed to you by the credit card company. For your records and convenience, we will send you a regular invoice showing date and amount of purchase. Inquiries regarding purchases, loss reports, ect., must be made to us.) **WE DO NOT PAY SHIPPING CHARGES.**

We cannot ship C.O.D. orders to Canada and other countries. C.O.D. fee for UPS is now \$9.00

Damaged Packages

If you receive a damaged package that was shipped by **UPS**, report the damage to the UPS office listed in your telephone directory. Then call us and we will replace the damaged items. The damage claim will be handled between us and UPS, but you must **call UPS first**.

If you receive a damaged package that was shipped by **Parcel Post**, you must take the package to your local post office for damage inspection and processing. They will handle the claim with you.

Returned Packages- By Carrier (UPS or USPS)

All orders returned to us because of: *Wrong Address, Not in on 3 delivery attempts, No Money, Does not want, Refused, Etc...* will be assessed a handling fee of \$5.00 plus the shipping charges. This helps us defray the extra costs of packaging.

Packages Not Received

If you do not receive your order within a reasonable amount of time, please contact us. We will be happy to check on the status of your order or place a tracer on it for you. With the new UPS tracking system, we have readily available to us UPS information by computer. This can usually tell us where your package is, although sometimes no information is available. If this is the case, then we can call UPS by telephone and request an urgent tracer, which will sometimes speed things up by alerting UPS that they may have misplaced a package.

Shortages

Please inspect shipments at once upon receipt and notify us of any discrepancies immediately. Please check all packing materials for missing items and invoice for possible back orders. Claims received after 10 days will not be honored.

COD's:

UPS no longer accepts cash for COD's. If you do not wish to disclose your micro numbers, you may pay UPS with a money order. If you have written us bad check in the past and are on our cash only list, your order will be sent for payment by a money order.



Rush Orders

During the busy season (Nov. thru Feb.) please add \$5.00 for Rush Orders. Ordinarily during less peak times we will put a rush on your order upon request without extra charges. Most orders will go out within 1-2 working days if all merchandise is in stock. Occasionally we will back order merchandise to prevent delays in shipping.

Foreign Customers

Canadian or foreign customers, please note that postal requirements do not permit C.O.D. Orders to Canada or foreign countries. Please remit in full when ordering. ALL Canadian checks or money orders *must* be payable in *U.S. Dollars* or they *will not* be accepted. A \$10.00 processing fee will be added to all foreign orders to countries other than Canada.



Returning Merchandise

In the event that it is necessary to return an item, please put a note in with the return explaining the reason and whether you want an exchange, refund or credit towards another order. You pay the postage for returning products. No C.O.D.'S will be accepted. Please insure all Parcel Post packages. UPS automatically insures up to \$100.00. NOTICE: All returns must be within 90 days from invoice date and a copy of the original invoice must accompany the return! After 90 days there will be a 10% restocking fee. We reserve the right to refuse returns that are older than 3 years or are in bad condition. All merchandise must be in saleable condition. Articles returned must be properly packed to insure against breakage in shipment as we cannot issue a refund or credit on a form broken in shipment.

WHAT IS IT?

Bess Maid Preservative is not just another dry “borax-only” preservative. It contains anti-microbial/anti-bacteria agents as well as other preserving agents. Bess Maid is a complete all round preservative — all you’ll ever need to preserve your mounts. We use it to preserve everything from a mouse to a moose, a fish to a fox, or a snake to a swan.



WASH , DRY AND SHAVE

First prepare the skin. *Note: If the skin has been salted, thoroughly remove all salt by washing it several times in clean , cold water.* Wash it in cold water and detergent and rinse in clean cold water. To reduce and kill bacteria, which is the primary cause of slippage in skins, we recommend adding Touchstone’s “**Relaxo**“, using cold water as instructed. When washing skins, use cold water because warm or hot water will cause bacteria to grow rapidly . The process of washing cleans the hair of blood, dirt and some oil.

After washing, squeeze the skin gently to remove the excess water, being careful not to ring it out or twist it like a rag as this could easily damage the hair. Next dry the hair side of the skin. We use a tumbler with sawdust. Then blow the excess sawdust out of the hair with an air hose. If you don’t have a tumbler, use a box or plastic garbage bag to shake the skin in. Don’t use a hair dryer because the heat promotes bacteria growth and is not good on the skin.

Now you’re ready to remove all the unwanted flesh (red meat and fat) from the flesh side of the skin. This can be done with a fleshing machine, by hand beaming (shaving) , or with a degreasing machine (a water-cooled turning wire brush system). **Note: If desired: apply preservative before fleshing to absorb excess moisture and to remove slickness of skin. If using this method, make sure to re-apply preservative after fleshing.** Be careful not to cut the hair roots off in the facial area. Using a sharp scalpel is good for the face, turning the lips, eyes, ears, and fleshing the nose down close. At this point, you can wash and dry the skin again if it has gotten soiled during the fleshing process.



HOW DO YOU USE IT?

To prepare the skin for mounting and to permanently preserve it, you simply apply Bess Maid in its dry form to the flesh side of the raw, shaven hide and you are ready to go. Mount it now or freeze it in an enclosed plastic bag till you can. You don’t salt it, soak it, or use any acid. Yes, it’s easy to use so don’t try to make it hard.

WHAT NEXT?



After about a week or so of drying under normal room temperature your mount should be dry and ready to apply the finishing touches. Finish it up, call your customer (who will be happy to have his trophy back so soon) and have the money in your pocket today. *See Next Page for Quantities & Pricing.*

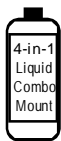

Good for making bodies for small fish. Can be used for making large fish bodies by using a wood or excelsior core. Apply a layer over the excelsior core and place inside the fish skin. Shape fish while plastolite is soft. When set, remove and dry plastolite body before mounting fish.

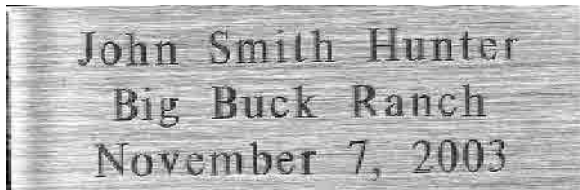
